

Eclipse/WOLips Cheat Sheet

General

⇧ ⌘ L – Show all keyboard shortcuts

⌘ 3 – Open “Quick Assist” browser

⇧ ⌘ X – Show “Open Component” browser

⇧ ⌘ R – Show “Open Resource” browser

⇧ ⌘ T – Show “Open Type” browser

⌘ F6 – Select Editor

Change key mappings:

Eclipse → Preferences → General → Keys

Package Explorer

REFACTORING

⌘ T – Show “Refactor” Menu

⌘ R – Rename File

⌘ V – Move File

Note: Rename WComponent by renaming it's Java file (not necessary in recent WOLips versions)

IMPORTS

⇧ ⌘ O – Organize imports

Component Editor

GENERAL

^Space – Content Assist

NAVIGATION

⌘ 1 – Switch to Java Editor

⌘ 2 – Switch to HTML Editor

⌘ 3 – Switch to WOD Editor

⌘ 4 – Switch to Preview

⌘ 5 – Switch to API Editor

REFACTORING

⌘ R – Rename...

⌘ W – Convert inline to wod

⇧ ⌘ F – Format

SHORTCUTS

Jump to Java file:

⌘ Click on WComponent name (WOD or inline)

Jump to Java method:

⌘ Click on binding (WOD or inline)

Add action or key to Java file:

Edit → Refactor → Add Action... or

Edit → Refactor → Add Key... or

⌘ Click on missing binding (WOD or inline)

Java Editor

CONTENT ASSIST

^Space – Content Assist

⇧ ^Space – Parameter Hints

^+ – in-place Content Assist

ERRORS

⌘ 1 – Quick Fix

CODING

⌘ S – Show “Source” Menu

⌘ Z – Show “Surround With” Menu

REFACTORING

⌘ T – Show “Refactor” Menu

⌘ R – Rename

⌘ V – Move

IMPORTS

⇧ ⌘ O – Organize imports

⇧ ⌘ M – Add import

Note: Either of these will add missing imports. Organize will remove unused ones. Automate by enabling: “Organize Imports” in: Eclipse → Preferences → Java → Editor → Save Actions

FORMATTING

⇧ ⌘ F – Reformat

⌘ I – Correct Indention

⌘ / – Comment/Uncomment
